RE: ROAD CLOSURE AT BURTON AVENUE, YONGE STREET AND GARDEN DRIVE

DATE: APRIL 30, 2018

The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council notice of a pending road closure required to facilitate repair and rehabilitation of the railway that crosses Burton Avenue / Yonge Street in proximity to Garden Drive. This work is scheduled to start May 8, 2018 and be completed through May 9, 2018.

Pending Closure of Burton Avenue at Garden Drive

The work proposed at the above mentioned location will allow staff of Cando Rail Services (Operators of the BCRY Railway) and its contractors the ability to repair and rehabilitate the railway crossing found at this point. This crossing has exceeded tolerances for safe rail use and requires immediate repairs.

A detour route is to be utilized during the closure to direct traffic around the works. Eastward traffic will be directed south via Garden Drive to Little Avenue. Westward traffic will be directed south via Huronia Road to Little Avenue. The traffic control plan prepared for this work reflects this detour route (see Figure 1). Bus Routes 4 & 8 will be impacted by the work, Transit Services will be providing advanced notice to the community of any delays or changes to these routes. Access to businesses in this area will be maintained throughout the duration of the work.
