RE: RECOGNITION OF RED STOREY (MOTION 17-G-247)

DATE: OCTOBER 23, 2017

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide additional information related to motion 17-G-247 concerning the Barrie Central realigned land ownership and land use concept (Staff Report PLN034-17). On Monday, October 16, 2017, staff were asked to provide a memorandum regarding the ability to carry forward Red Storey's legacy after the development of Red Storey Field. Discussions are underway with HIP development regarding recognition of Red Storey within their development proposal.

However, should the site not allow for an appropriate commemoration, City Council may wish to consider naming another field or park in recognition of Red Storey. In accordance with the Commemorative Naming Policy, Council could pass a motion such as the following:

"That in light of Red Storey's significant contributions to the community and the proposed HIP development plans associated with the current Red Storey Field, a field or park in the Hewitt's or Salem lands be named in his honour."
