Initially the ask from Mr Massie and team was to locate this potential facility on the one remaining piece of waterfront, east of the South Shore Community Centre. Is this still the ask? The motion only reflects "within" the City limits.

The other question is, as a City... do we have the stomach for it and can we sustain it. Answers will come in due course if we move forward with this motion.
