

BY-LAW NUMBER 2018 -

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to appoint a Fire Chief for the City of Barrie and to repeal By-law 2017-113.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.M.25 ("the Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides that a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 227, of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, it is the role of the officers and employees of the municipality to implement council's decisions and establish administrative practices and procedures to carry out council's decisions; to undertake research and provide advice to council on the policies and programs of the municipality and to carry out other duties as required under this or any Act and other duties assigned by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS, Section 6 (1) of the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act*, S.O. 1997, c. 4, states that the council of a municipality shall appoint a Fire Chief for the fire department;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with motion 18-G-025, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to appoint Cory David Mainprize to the position of Fire Chief for The Corporation of the City of Barrie;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Cory David Mainprize be appointed as the Fire Chief for the City of Barrie and for the term of his employment as Fire Chief.
- 2. That By-law 2017-113 be repealed.
- THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 5th day of March, 2018.

READ a third time and finally passed this 5th day of March, 2018.
