**BY-LAW NUMBER 2018-**

**A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie  
to appoint a Deputy Treasurer and to repeal By-  
law 2013-156.**

**WHEREAS** Section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, ("the Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 286(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that a municipality shall appoint a treasurer who is responsible for handling all of the financial affairs of the municipality on behalf of and in the manner directed by the council of the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 286(2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that a municipality may appoint deputy treasurers who shall have all the powers and duties of the treasurer under this and any other Act.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Jennifer Cowles be appointed as a Deputy Treasurer for the City of Barrie for the term of her employment.
2. **THAT** By-law 2013-156 being a by-law to appoint Michael Douglas Jerney as a Deputy Treasurer be repealed.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2018.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2018.
