This year Recreation Services is offering over 50 different and unique camps, many with multiple date options for a total of over 200 camp options. With this many camps we aim to have something for everyone between the ages of 4 and up! We offer active camps, creative camps, outdoor camps, general camps, science and technology camps, youth camps, and inclusion camps.

Here are a few of our brand new camps this Summer:

Base Camp at the Barrie Community Sports Complex: A traditional day camp program offering a unique balance of summer camp experiences! Our camp schedule is filled with a variety of exciting activities including arts and crafts, sports and games, nature awareness, outdoor play, skill development, canoeing, outdoor living skills and making memories to last a lifetime.
