Students are back in school, the leaves will begin to change colour, and the Community Centre ice rinks will be in full swing once again! Our facility staff teams are working hard to re-build the ice and, once finished, our skating drop-in sessions will soon be open! Recreation Services offers a variety of skating drop-in sessions for all the skaters in our community!

## <u>Skating</u>

**Public Skating -** Grab your skates, helmet, and your family or friends and come out to pleasure skate. There are no pucks or sticks on the ice. All skaters under the age of 10 should be accompanied by a guardian of at least 12 years old.

Senior/Adult Skating – This program is for those 18+ years.

**Shinny –** Pack your helmet, recommended to include a cage, your skates and your stick to practice shooting on an open net and your stick handling skills.

Youth Shinny - youth must be between the ages of 13 and 17 years old

Adult & Child Shinny - children must be between the ages of 5 and 12 years old and must be accompanied by a guardian of at least 12 years old.

**Family Shinny –** this program is for all ages!

Adult Shinny – this program is for those 18+ years.

**Hockey -** Hockey drop-in sessions are supervised but, like shinny, are an informal session. Hockey dropin sessions require full equipment for players and goalies.

Adult Hockey -- players and goalies must be at least 18 years old

Seniors Hockey – players and goalies must be at least 60 years old

Adult Hockey Skills – Come out and practice your passing and shooting.

For all programs, no pre-registration is required and spaces are available on a first come first served basis. Sign in commences 30 minutes before ice time.
