Report on Statistics – Deputy Chief Ken Weatherill

Deputy Chief Weatherill provided a PowerPoint presentation giving an overview of the monthly statistics for December 2018. There were concerns with the Provincial Offences Notices (PONs) being much lower then 2017. Deputy Weatherill advised that is directly related to the legalization of cannabis. Officers from the Traffic Unit have been directly involved with Standardized Field Sobriety (SFST) and Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) training which left the Traffic Unit complement at 50%. For 2019 4 weeks have been identified for a traffic initiative to focus on enforcement.
