The purpose of this Memo is to apprise Members of General Committee of the upcoming annual Spring Into Clean Community Clean-Up Event scheduled for April 26th to 28th, 2019.

The Agenda for the event is as follows:

- 1. Friday, April 26th, 2019 **Schools Participation Clean Up**: Includes area parks and neighbourhoods around the schools. Registration deadline is Friday April 6th, 2018, online at: www.barrie.ca;
- 2. Saturday, April 27th, 2019 will include a Waterfront Clean-Up event from 9:00am 1:00pm in Heritage Park. No registration is required for this event and residents are invited to participate in a complimentary BBQ following the clean-up; and
- 3. Sunday, April 28th, 2019 **Community Groups Clean Up**: Includes groups and businesses cleaning of parks and public spaces. Registration deadline is Friday April 6th, 2018, online at: www.barrie.ca.

Additionally, residents, families, businesses and other community organizations will be encouraged to participate in clean-ups in public parks and green spaces throughout the City by visiting our website to register.

In 2018, a total of 18,000 residents participated in the Spring Into Clean Event with the collection of more than 4.9 tonnes of litter which is approximately over 500 Spring Into Clean bags from across 107 different parks, trails, roadways and public spaces throughout the City. This year, a greater participation rate is expected.
