Clarification of Sign By-law in Barrie

(Barrie, ON) Recently, the City of Barrie's Municipal Law Enforcement Officers removed a number of signs that were installed on municipal property. The removal of these signs was done in accordance with the City's Sign By-law.

The City of Barrie Sign-By-law prohibits any sign from being installed on municipal property (which includes boulevards). Signs are permitted to be posted on residential private property as long as the content of the sign is not offensive or includes commercial advertising.

If a sign is found in the City that is not compliant with the Sign By-law, the sign is removed by a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and the organization or business which is displayed on the sign is assessed a fee of \$76.50 per sign.
