Civic Holiday in Barrie: Affected Services

(Barrie, ON) A number of services are affected by holiday weekends. The following City of Barrie services will be affected on Monday, August 5.

Barrie Transit

Transit will operate a regular Sunday Service schedule on Monday, August 5, with extra Kempenfest Service all weekend. Visit barrie.ca/TransitNotices for schedules.

Curbside Collection

There will be no garbage, organics, recycling or yard waste collection on Monday, August 5 in Barrie. Collection during the week of this holiday will occur one day later for the remainder of the week. Materials must be curbside by 7 a.m. on your collection day (barrie.ca/CurbsideCollection). Note: The landfill site is closed regularly every Sunday and Monday.

Recreation Centres

All City recreation facilities will be closed Monday, August 5 for the Civic Holiday.

Parking

Downtown parking (on-street and lots) is free on weekends and statutory holidays. Waterfront parking is enforced 24/7/365. Residents must display their permits and visitors are required to pay \$3 per hour with a daily maximum of \$15 (www.barrie.ca/parking)

City Hall

Barrie City Hall will be closed on Monday, August 5.
