




Background

- Met with Seniors Advisory Committee on March 11th to Discuss Transit Options for Seniors – Free Month (June) or Free Day Every Week (Tuesdays) Year Round
- Motion to General Committee on April 15th That during the month of June, 2019 free transit services be provided to seniors in recognition of "Seniors' Month"
- Conducted Surveys in June (During Free Month) & Early July
- Received 93 Responses On-line (39) and In Person (54)




Q1 How did you hear about FREE Transit for Seniors in the month of June?








Q2 Have you used Barrie Transit before June 1st, 2019 in the past 12 months?





Q3 Where will you plan to travel on Barrie Transit during the month of June? Check all that apply.




Q4 What would be your preferred option to give Seniors an opportunity to try Barrie Transit at no cost and gain comfort using the system?




4B If there was a day of the week that seniors could ride Barrie Transit for FREE, what day of the week would you prefer?



Recommendation - FREE Day of the Week & Monthly Pass Subsidy

- 52 Free Days of Transit
- Further subsidization for Monthly Passes
- Year Round Opportunity to Use Transit at No Cost
- A Day Every Week to Run Errands, Attend Medical Appointments, Visit Friends/Family
- Alternative Travel Option During Winter Months
- Helps Combat Isolation



Recommended Motions

- That on every, (insert day) of each week, seniors ages 65 and up be provided free transit services within the City of Barrie.
- That the Fees By-law 2019-023 be amended to reduce the seniors monthly transit pass from \$56.50 to \$53.00 effective November 1, 2019.
