RE:	UPDATE ON THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE (EV) CHARGING STATIONS

The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council with an update concerning the installation of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations as outlined in Council motion 17-G-285. Staff previously updated Council on the EV charging stations deployment on February 11, 2019 which recommended further communication in the fall of 2019.

Staff in the Transit and Parking Strategy Department are currently undertaking the development of a parking strategy that aims to identify solutions for the current parking challenges in the downtown and waterfront areas. This strategy will support the anticipated City growth over the next 20 years and ensure long term financial sustainability for these services. It is anticipated that the parking strategy and accompanying recommendations will be presented to Council in Q1 2020.

The parking strategy will include considerations of the current EV charge station locations, use and associated impacts as part of holistic review of the downtown and waterfront parking system. Staff plan to bring forth EV parking recommendations and policy considerations to Council as part of the overall parking strategy staff report.
