The LOCATION

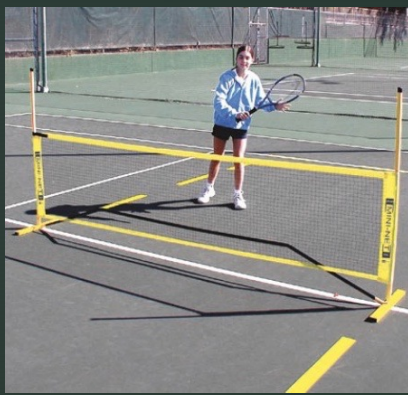
- The Eastview Tennis Club is located on Grove Street behind the Hockey Arena and consists of 4 newly resurfaced courts, lighting and completely fenced in area.
- Currently there is a portable toilet on site, a kids playground beside the tennis courts and garbage and recycling disposal





The UNIT

- A 12 x 8 x 8.5 Height Heartland Stratford (or similar) Garden Shed with Plastic Window and lockable door (see pictures)
- Extra Wide Doors for easy movement in and out.
- Strong and Sturdy Construction making it hard to vandalize
- Estimated cost \$2000
- Set up and Assembly...



WHAT WOULD BE STORED

- Tennis Balls (Red, Orange, Green, and Yellow Balls)
- PickleBall Balls
- Mini Nets for Progressive Tennis Play and PickleBall
- Water Removal Brushes, Rollers and Squegies
- Spare Rackets (Tennis and PickleBall)
- Lines (Non Marking on and off again) for Progressive Tennis and PickleBall





TENNIS PLAYERS estimated 50-70

- The City of Barrie has been offering Tennis Lessons through Simcoe Tennis every spring since 2007. These are coached by certified coaching professionals and are for children aged 4-18 as well as adults of all levels.
- Simcoe Tennis has been hiring the courts at Eastview since 2007 to host Interclub teams from as far away as Pickering, Ajax, and London.
- To run HouseLeague at Eastview with many championship matches being played on these courts
- To run Skyhawk Lesson programs for players of all ages since 2007 on these courts

GENERAL PUBLIC TENNIS PLAYERS estimated 30-50

- General Public use of the courts has increased since the resurfacing and users have expressed an interest in being able to clear courts off from rain if there was a spot to store court cleaners
- We have individuals in mind who will take on this role and responsibility
- General Public use ranges from children in the neighborhood, teenagers interested in the game, young adults, parents with their kids, middle aged adults and senior players.




EASTVIEW HIGH SCHOOL

estimated 100+

- Eastview High School uses the courts for PE classes and carries a great deal of equipment over each time. Simcoe Tennis has supplied the school with balls, rackets and mini nets for their Physical Education program as well as trained their staff on the most efficient ways of teaching large groups of students the basic fundamentals of the game.



PICKLEBALL PLAYERS estimated 15-20

- Pickleball is a fast growing sport in our community. Pickleball uses small mini nets as well Paddles to play.
 - The courts are smaller and need lines placed on the court for play.
 - We are also in contact with The PickleBall community and they are aware of this proposal.

FREQUENCY OF USE

- Currently the courts are used for lessons through The City of Barrie and Simcoe Tennis programs 4 days per week from May until June
- Public Usage is busiest weekday mornings, evenings and weekends.
- Eastview HS uses courts at various times throughout the day

- PickleBall/Tennis Events on weekends throughout the summer months. Hosting clubs throughout Central Ontario

 - Adult League Play in both the ICTA and PickleBall League Play
