Re: Proposed Additions to Municipal Heritage Register

We are the Allandale Neighbourhood Association. As you are aware, there are a number of buildings in Allandale that are worthy of protection as heritage buildings. We have consulted the City of Barrie's procedure for listing non-designated properties on the Municipal Heritage Register. We hereby request, as an advisory committee, that the following properties be placed on the Register:

1. The Farmhouse Restaurant – 268 Bradford Street
2. 5 Tiffin Street
3. 4 Essa Road
4. 8 Essa Road
5. 66 Tiffin Street, formerly Allandale Schoolhouse
6. Essa Road Presbyterian Church – 59 Essa Road
7. Loyal Order of Orange Lodge – 7 Burton Avenue
8. Unity Christian High School, formerly King Edward Elementary School – 25 Burton Avenue
9. St. George's Anglican Church – 9 Granville Street
10. Burton Avenue United Church – 37 Burton Avenue.

Each of these buildings has played a significant role in the public life of Allandale. Some are now occupied by tenants and some are occupied by owners. We have had difficulty contacting owners in some cases.

Attached are photographs of each building. With respect to 66 Tiffin Street, we are advised that the interior is somewhat preserved. It is a wooden dome construction with the initials of students carved in the beams. Like 66 Tiffin Street, each of these buildings has historical significance. Each of the churches, for example, recently assembled a history for presentation at an Allandale Neighbourhood Association meeting. Many of the buildings are documented in historical photographs.

We ask that you kindly begin the process set out in your Municipal Heritage Register fact sheet and advise us if there is anything else you need from us at this point.
