About the Barrie Police Service

- Existed since 1853 the second oldest active police service in the Province of Ontario.
- 64,739 calls for service in 2018
- Provide policing to a city of 150,000 + visitors
- Specialized services include:
 - K9 (celebrating 20 years in 2019)

 - Traffic Unit




Number of Study Flags Reported
