RE: APPLICATION FOR RESIDENTS TO SUGGEST SPEED BUMP LOCATIONS

The purpose of this memo is to update Council on the motion 19-G 344 approved on November 18, 2019, for staff in Access Barrie and Roads, Parks and Fleet Departments to investigate the feasibility of creating a centralized system for residents to recommend speed bump locations.

Staff have created a GIS map for residents to suggest locations in the City where they would like to see a speed bump. Residents can use this application to submit a location or “like” a location already submitted, for the City to consider putting a speed bump in 2021. The City will collect submissions until November 13, 2020.

The submissions received from the public will be shared with Members of Council in January 2021 to help Councillors decide where speed bumps should be placed in each ward in 2021.
