GENERAL UPDATES

J. Sharp, Supervisor of Traffic Operations and Community Safety provided an update from the Roads, Parks and Fleet Department on matters relating to:

- The installation of a school crossing flashing beacon at Blake Street and Huron Street; and
- The relocation of community safety zone signage on Adam Street.
