SECTION "A"

PRESENTATION CONCERNING A SHIFT GOVERNMENT PROJECT REGARDING STUDENT AND SENIOR HOMESHARE PILOT OPPORTUNITIES

Mayor, J. Lehman provided a presentation to the Committee concerning a Shift Government Project regarding a proposal for a Student and Senior Homeshare Pilot Program.

Mayor Lehman discussed the following information:

- An overview on the Shift Government initiatives dedicated to route problems and prevention such as aging in place, food support, and the Opioid crisis;
- The Shift Government Team;
- Examples of successful Student and Senior Homeshare programs in the municipalities of Hamilton and Toronto;
- The concept of the Homeshare Program:
 - Partnership with Georgian College;
 - A coordinator position set up by Georgian College for the Pilot Program;
 - Connecting seniors with students;
 - Students enrolled in program with experience, nursing, social services etc.;
 - Student assisting with food, odd jobs, shoveling snow etc.;
 - Low rent costs;
 - Forming a relationship and eliminating isolation of seniors and students;
 - A framework agreement assisting on how they want to live and developing a relationship.
 - A helpline to assist with issues or challenges;

The Committee asked a number of questions to Mayor Lehman and City staff and received responses.

The Seniors Advisory Committee met and recommends adoption of the following recommendation(s):

SECTION "B"

HOMESHARE FOR STUDENTS AND SENIORS PILOT PROGRAM

- 1. That a one year Student and Seniors Homeshare Pilot Program in partnership with the Georgian College be supported and that commitment funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 from the Community Benefit Reserve be approved.
- 2. That once the Student and Seniors Homeshare Pilot Program is in place an update be provided to the Seniors Advisory Committee on the progress of the Pilot Program.

This matter was recommended (Section "B") to Finance and Corporate Services Committee for consideration of adoption at its meeting to be held on 11/6/2019.
