The following organizations provided proposals concerning a sport event/facilities opportunity for the City of Barrie:

#### 1. Barrie Sports Dome

The Barrie Sports Dome presentation was rescheduled to a future meeting.

#### 2. Barrie Cricket League Inc.

Jashank Vyas, member of the Barrie Cricket League Inc. provided a presentation concerning a proposal for a designated Cricket field at Maitland Park.

Mr. Vyas discussed slides concerning the following topics:

- A summary of the game of Cricket both abroad and in Canada;
- A diagram illustrating a Cricket Pitch;
- A summary on the Barrie Cricket Leagues need for a permanent Cricket facility in the City of Barrie;
