- Charts illustrating the following topics:
  - o Total incident response and incidents over the past nine years;
  - o The percentage increase in incident volumes over the past nine years;
  - o The number of incidents by month for the years 2016 - 2017;
  - o The six minutes road response percentages between 2010 - 2017;
  - o The 2017 percentages of incidents by type;
  - o The percentages of incident response types for a five year average versus 2017;
  - o The number of incident responses by type for a five year average versus 2016;
  - o The number of fires with a dollar loss between 2010 - 2017;
- A map illustrating the location of 2017 fires;
- A chart illustrating the total dollar losses between 2010 - 2017; and
- Future initiatives associated to education, planning, procedure reviews, staff training and support programs.
