



BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to accept the “as-constructed” municipal services within and complementary to the Lakeside Cove Residential Subdivision registered as 51M-928 and to assume the streets for public use.

WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the “Municipal Act, 2001”), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the *Municipal Act, 2001* or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to assume all of Bayshore Boulevard, Tamarack Trail, Plunkett Court, Capps Drive, Royal Park Boulevard and Turner Drive within the limits of the Lakeside Cove Residential Subdivision registered as Plan 51M-928;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to accept the “as constructed” municipal services within and complementary to the Lakeside Cove Residential Subdivision as identified on Appendix “A” attached to this By-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed Motion 11-G-276 delegating authority to the Director of Engineering to accept the municipal infrastructure within Plans of Subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** all of Bayshore Boulevard, Tamarack Trail, Plunkett Court, Capps Drive, Royal Park Boulevard and Turner Drive within the limits of the Lakeside Cove Subdivision registered as Plan 51M-928, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe be assumed for public use.
2. **THAT** the “as constructed” municipal services within and complementary to the Lakeside Cove Residential Subdivision registered as Plan 51M-928 as identified on Appendix “A” attached to this By-law be accepted.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 24th day of October, 2016.

READ a third time and finally passed this 24th day of October, 2016.
