The event offers FREE outdoor activities including skating, broomball, horse-drawn sleigh rides, climbing wall, kicksleds, trail walking and a bonfire. Plus, meet some of the Barrie Baycats, get autographs, tickets and pictures with the championship trophy!

For those looking for indoor fun, all three recreation centres are open for programming (including fitness centres) from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Family Day. Family Day Drop-In schedules are available at www.barrie.ca/DropIns.

Family Day Affected Services:

- **Barrie Transit** will operate according to the regular Sunday service schedule. Visit www.barrie.ca/TransitNotices for details.
- **Curbside Collection:** There will be no garbage, organics, or recycling collection on Family Day in Barrie. Collection during the week of this holiday will occur ONE day later for the remainder of the week. Visit www.barrie.ca/CurbsideCollection for details.
- **City Hall** will be closed.
- **Parking:** Downtown parking (on-street and lots) is free on all statutory holidays. Waterfront parking is enforced 24/7/365; residents must display their permits and visitors are required to pay \$3/hour (daily maximum: \$20). Visit www.barrie.ca/Parking for details.
