**The Heritage Barrie Committee met and reports as follows:**

**SECTION "A"**

**HERITAGE DESIGNATION - CONDITION OF DEVELOPMENT 142  
COLLINGWOOD STREET**

Kathy Brislin, Senior Policy Planner reviewed highlights of the Heritage Designation Report dated March 7, 2016 prepared by Su Murdoch Historical Consulting for the residential property located at 142 Collingwood Street. Ms. Brislin noted that the Heritage Designation Report included the interior attributes of this residential property.

K. Brislin introduced Cameron Sellers who was representing the applicant. Mr. Sellers reviewed the Heritage Designation process utilized for 142 Collingwood Street. He noted that the process included meetings with the City's Committee of Adjustment and a public open house.

The Committee members asked Mr. Sellers a number of questions related to the information provided and received responses.

**HERITAGE DESIGNATION - CONDITION OF DEVELOPMENT 142

1. That a By-law be passed to designate 142 Collingwood Street as being a property of architectural and historical value under Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act.
2. That the Statement of Cultural and Heritage Value or Interest and Description of Heritage Attributes, appended as Schedule "B" to the report dated March 7, 2016 prepared by Su Murdoch Historical Consulting, be included as a Schedule to the By-law.
