

OVERNIGHT PARKING PROHIBITION BRIGHTON ROAD WARD 1 FILE (T08-VA)

The following represents an in-depth survey of the residents of Brighton Road regarding parking conducted 09-12 Jun 2016
There are **84** homes on Brighton Road of which this survey had **65** respondents equivalent to **75.5%** replies.

Option "A" – Maintain current parking restrictions	41	63%
Option "B" - No parking on the North Side	4	6%

Other Options / Preferences brought forth by the Residents of Brighton Road

No parking on the South Side	13	20%
On street parking only with an issued parking pass	2	3%
No parking on North side or "No Parking"	1	1.5%
No parking or parking only with an issued parking pass	1	1.5%
Alternate North & South side parking by date	1	1.5%
No Parking	1	1.5%
Declined to respond	1	1.5%

Of the 41 respondents the opted for Option "A" Maintain current parking restrictions, 5 replies indicated that their 2nd choice would be "No Parking on the South side"


