

BY-LAW NUMBER 2013-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to accept the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the 1616678 Ontario Ltd. - Hamptons Plan of Subdivision (Phase 1 East and Phase 2) Registered as Plan 51M-820 and to assume the streets within this plan of subdivision for public use.

WHEREAS Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the "Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Municipal Act, 2001 or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to assume part of Westminster Circle, part of Connaught Lane, part of Sovereign's Gate, part of Charlemagne Avenue, part of Empire Drive, part of Tudor Crescent and The Queensway on Plan 51M-820, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as shown in grey on Schedule "A" attached;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed Motion 11-G-276 delegating authority to the Director of Engineering to accept the municipal infrastructure within Plans of Subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- THAT that part of Westminster Circle, part of Connaught Lane, part of Sovereign's Gate, part of Charlemagne Avenue, part of Empire Drive, part of Tudor Crescent and The Queensway on Plan 51M-820 as shown in grey on Schedule "A" attached be assumed for public use.
- 2. **THAT** the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the 1616678 Ontario Ltd. Hamptons Plan of Subdivision (Phase 1 East and Phase 2) Registered as Plan 51M-820 as shown in grey on Schedule "A" attached be accepted.
- THAT this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 3rd day of June, 2013.

READ a third time and finally passed this 3rd day of June, 2013.
