

BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to further amend By-law 2015-025 as amended with respect to the establishment and requirement of the payment of fees for information, services, activities and use of City property.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie may pass by-laws establishing and requiring the payment of fees for information, services, activities and use of City property;

AND WHEREAS Section 391 of the *Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001*, as amended, provides for a municipality to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on persons for services and activities provided or done by or on behalf of it, for cost payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board, and for the use of its property including property under its control;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacted By-law 2015-025 with respect to the establishment and requirement of the payment of fees for information, services, activities and use of City property;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to motion 15-G-214, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to further amend By-law 2015-025 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** By-law Number 2015-025 be amended by deleting Schedule "B" and replacing it with Schedule "B" attached hereto, forming part of this by-law.
- 2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

NOTES:

Except as provided in sections 1.2, 1.11 and 1.12, the permit fee for a project shall be calculated by:

- a) Determining the occupancy classification, gross floor area and scope of work for which the permit applies;
- b) Multiplying the fee rate listed in sections 1.3 to 1.8 by the appropriate measure;
- c) Adding any additional fee rates listed in 1.9 and 1.10; and
- d) Ensuring the total permit fee is at least the minimum fee listed in section 1.1.

Except as provided in the additional fee rates listed in sections 1.9 and 1.10, all plumbing, heating, air conditioning and ventilation work associated with a project and shown on the permit drawings are included in the base fee rate. Fees not listed shall be determined by the Chief Building Official by reasonable caparison with the listed fee rates.
