SIR ROBERT BARRIE STATUE/ BUST - DESIGN/CRITERIA DISCUSSION

O. Groves, Culture Officer, Development, presented an overview of current Canadian Public Art. The Committee discussed their preference to commission two (2) conventionally representative life-size statues of a youthful Sir Robert Barrie that could be placed in a local City park and within City Hall. Ms. Groves will investigate cost of commissioning the statues by a local artist and report back to the Committee.
