BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to establish Part of Lot 9, Plan 898, formerly Township of Innisfil, designated as Part 1 on Plan 51R-38614, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as a public highway, and to name the highway Yonge Street.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 ("the Municipal Act"), provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, provides that Sections 8 and 11 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to (a) enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and, (b) enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 11 of the *Municipal Act*, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein including, *inter alia*, highways;

AND WHEREAS Section 31 of the *Municipal Act*, provides that every municipality may pass by-laws for assumption, establishing or widening of highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie adopted Motion 12-G-213;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to establish Part of Lot 9, Plan 898, formerly Township of Innisfil, designated as Part 1 on Plan 51R-38614, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as a public highway, and to name the highway Yonge Street.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts the following:

- 1. **THAT** Part of Lot 9, Plan 898, formerly Township of Innisfil, designated as Part 1 on Plan 51R-38614, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe be established as a public highway, and to name the highway Yonge Street.
- 2. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
