



BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to amend By-law 2007-210 as amended being a by-law to regulate Outdoor Solid Fuel Burning Appliances.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 (“the *Municipal Act*, 2001”), provides that Sections 9 and 10 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to (a) enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and, (b) enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising the authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

AND WHEREAS, the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act*, 1997, S.O. 1997, c. 4, Section 7.1(1) provides that a council of the municipality may pass by-laws regulating the setting of open air fires, including establishing the times during which open air fires may be set;

AND WHEREAS on the 27th day of September, 2007 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed By-law 2007-210 as amended being a by-law to regulate outdoor solid fuel burning appliances within the City of Barrie;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to motion 15-G-049 as amended, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie has deemed it expedient to amend the Fees By-law and other by-laws as deemed necessary to address fee changes as appropriate;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Section 5.3.0 of By-law 2007-210 as amended be deleted and replaced with the following:

“5.3.0 be accompanied by payment of the required fee in accordance with the City of Barrie Fee’s By-law as amended from time to time”.

2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect on May 1, 2015.

READ a first and second time this 30th day of March, 2015.

READ a third time and finally passed this 30th day of March, 2015.
