

BY-LAW NUMBER 2019-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to require a by-election to fill the vacancy in the office of a member of Council representing Ward Three.

WHEREAS, Section 258 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* as amended (the "*Municipal Act, 2001*"), establishes that a member of the Assembly as provided in the *Legislative Assembly Act* or of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada is ineligible to hold office as a member of council;

AND WHEREAS, Councillor D. Shipley was elected as a member of the House of Commons on October 22, 2019;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 262 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, Barrie City Council declared the office to be vacant on October 28, 2019;

AND WHEREAS, Section 263 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the "Municipal Act, 2001"), establishes that where a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of Council of a municipality, the Council may by by-law require a by-election to be held to fill the vacancy;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with motion 19-G-338, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to require that a by-election be held to fill the vacancy in the office of Councillor – Ward Three;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** a by-election be held to fill the vacancy for the office of a member of Council representing Ward Three in the City of Barrie, to be conducted in accordance with Section 65 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, R.S.O. 1996.
- 2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a third time and finally passed this 25th day of November, 2019.
