The Heritage Barrie Committee met and reports as follows:

HERITAGE STAKEHOLDERS' MEETING - OVERVIEW AND UPDATE

K. Brislin, Senior Policy Planner provided an update on the Heritage Barrie stakeholders' meeting held on May 5, 2015 at Barrie City Hall. She noted that representatives from the following groups attended the stakeholders' meeting:

- Allandale Neighbourhood Association;
- Barrie Downtown Neighbourhood Association;
- Barrie Historical Association;
- · Historic Neighbourhoods Strategy Community Committee; and
- Heritage Barrie Committee.

Ms. Brislin summarized the key findings at the stakeholders' meeting as follows:

- Liaise with Tourism Barrie, the Culture Department and Economic Development to promote cultural events focusing on local artisans;
