**BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-**

**A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to  
require a by-election to fill the vacancy in the office  
of a member of Council representing Ward Seven.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 258 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the "*Municipal Act, 2001*"), establishes that a member of the Assembly as provided in the *Legislative Assembly Act* or of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada is ineligible to hold office as a member of council;

**AND WHEREAS**, Councillor J. Brassard was elected as a member of the House of Commons on October 19, 2015;

**AND WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 262 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, Barrie City Council declared the office to be vacant on October 26, 2015;

**AND WHEREAS**, Section 263 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the "*Municipal Act, 2001*"), establishes that where a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of Council of a municipality, the Council may by by-law require a by-election to be held to fill the vacancy;

**AND WHEREAS**, in accordance with motion 15-G-218, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to require that a by-election be held to fill the vacancy in the office of Councillor – Ward Seven;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** a by-election be held to fill the vacancy for the office of a member of Council representing Ward Seven in the City of Barrie, to be conducted in accordance with Section 65 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, R.S.O. 1996.
2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2015.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2015.
