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The Finance and Corporate Services Committee met and reports as follows:

PRESENTATION BY C. GLASER, DIRECTOR OF INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY REGARDING AN OVERVIEW OF THE CORPORATE IT STRATEGY

C. Glaser, Director of Information and Communications Technology provided the Committee with a presentation concerning the Corporate Information Technology (IT) Strategy. She outlined the various municipal services that rely on technology and the customers of information technology, including both internal and external customers. Ms. Glaser described the areas of focus in the Corporate IT Strategy.

Councillor A. Nuttall joined the meeting at 6:18 p.m.

Ms. Glaser highlighted the following Corporate IT Strategy themes:

- Flexible, reliable infrastructure for the future
- Digitize core processes into Corporate Business Systems
- Mobilize the workforce
- Embrace consumer like devices and services for improved productivity and collaboration
- Improve IT service delivery

Ms. Glaser reviewed the aims and outcomes associated with each of the themes. She concluded by commenting that the technology strategy requires a corporate scale transformation and outlined key areas necessary for implementation.
