

BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to amend By-law 2006-266 as amended being a by-law to licence, regulate and govern businesses carried on within the municipality.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 ("The Municipal Act, 2001")* provides that the Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising the authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

AND WHEREAS on the 30th day of October 2006, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed By-law 2006-266 being a by-law to licence, regulate and govern businesses carried on within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to motion 16-G-209 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie has deemed it expedient to further amend By-law 2006-266 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Section 26.0.0.0, OPERATING CRITERIA FOR CIRCUSES & SIMILAR SHOWS, of By-law 2006-266 as amended, be further amended by adding the following:
 - 26.2.7.0.0 Notwithstanding the above, the use or display of wildlife or exotic animals shall be prohibited.
- 2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect on the passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 24th day of October, 2016.

READ a third time and finally passed this 24th day of October, 2016.
