RE: PARTS 1 AND 2, PLAN 51R-28664, CUMMING DRIVE AND BLOOM CRESCENT, PLAN OF SUBDIVISION 51M-721

This Memorandum is being presented to Council to provide further information regarding the attached Bill.

On September 19, 2000 by Transfer/Deed Instrument Number LT452155, The Corporation of the City of Barrie (the "City") acquired Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 51R-28664 "for municipal" purposes and passed By-Law 2000-231 on October 2, 2000 to confirm the acquisition.

Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 51R-28664 are currently being operated by the City as parts of municipal highways. Part 1 on Plan 51R-28664 is currently operated as a part of Cumming Drive, and Part 2 on Plan 51R-28664 is currently operated as a part of Bloom Crescent. Parts 1 and 2 are not named as municipal highways on Plan 51R-28664.

On June 25th, 2012, the City assumed the as-constructed municipal services within Plan 51M-721 under By-Law 2012-121. Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 51R-28664 are included on Plan 51M-721 but are not named as municipal highways.

Although Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 51R-28664 have been operated as roads by the City, because they are not set out or named on Plan 51M-721 as municipal highways, parts 1 and 2 on Plan 51R-28664 were not named or assumed as municipal highways when the City passed By-Law 2012-121 assuming the as-constructed municipal services within Plan 51M-721.

The purpose of this By-Law therefore is to officially name and assume Part1 on Plan 51R-28664 as Cumming Drive, and Part 2 on Plan 51R-28664 as Bloom Crescent.



BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to establish Parts 1 & 2, Plan 51R-28664, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as part of the municipal highway system.

WHEREAS Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the "Act"), provides that a single tier Municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein, including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Barrie acquired Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 51R-28664, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe for municipal purposes on September 19, 2000 and passed By-Law 2000-131 to confirm the acquisition;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Barrie assumed the as-constructed municipal services within and complementary to the plan of subdivision registered as 51M-721 for public use, which plan included Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 51R-38664, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe and passed By-Law 2012-121 to confirm the assumption;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to establish Parts 1 and 2, Plan 51R-28664 as part of the municipal highway system;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts the following:

1. **THAT** Part 1, Plan 51R-28664, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe be established as part of the municipal highway system and be named Cumming Drive;
2. **THAT** Part 2, Plan 51R-28664, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe be established as part of the municipal highway system and be named Bloom Crescent;
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 2nd day of June, 2014.

READ a third time and finally passed this 2nd day of June, 2014.
