



A game changer: Volt Hockey

Volt hockey is an accessible form of floor hockey, geared towards young players with lower mobility difficulties, such as muscular dystrophy, cerebral palsy, spina bifida, osteoporosis and dwarfism.

The custom - built motorized wheelchairs come equipped with a four-point harness seatbelt for the player. To play the game, the toe of a hockey stick is mounted to the front of each chair to allow players to pass, shoot, and control the ball using a built-in joystick.

The game is played by two teams in an indoor court or gymnasium. Normally there are three players on each team, with two 15-minute halves in the game and two referees.

Hockey is Canada's game, which is why everyone deserves the chance to play. Volt Hockey opens the doors to athletes, allowing those who have not yet been able to play the opportunity to do so.
