This initiative is a collaboration of 2 youth centred organizations representing a future charity, these are; Smart Moves Play Place in Barrie's south-end (voted Barrie's Best Children's play centre for 3 years) and Elephant Thoughts a well established Collingwood-based charity, and winner of the 2016 NSERC award for science education.

The Barrie Children's Museum will be a hands-on, physically active, and learning-through-play environment for children 1-12 years. The focus of the museum will be on local history, indigenous people and the environment.

The Barrie Children's Museum (BCM) will be a year round community, and regional hub in Barrie's city centre.
