### Motion for Consideration:

That staff in the Development Services Department investigate possible solutions to minimize the possibility of traffic and pedestrian incidents at the intersection of Mulcaster Street and Worsley Street caused by blind spots when travelling west on Worsley Street through the intersection at Mulcaster Street and report back to the Community Safety Committee.

### Reason or Rationale in support of the motion:

For many years residents have been concerned about the blind spot they encounter when attempting to either turn north or south or through the intersection when travelling west on Worsley Street. This situation has escalated with the increase in occupants of the City Centre Building and will continue to escalate as the building's population grows to capacity. The street parking on Mulcaster Street just south of the intersection makes it very difficult for motorists to see oncoming northbound traffic until they are well past the stop sign and into the intersection.
