

BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to appoint Jeffrey Steven Weber as Community Emergency Management Coordinator for the City of Barrie and to repeal By-law 2013-095.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.M.25 ("the *Municipal Act*, 2001"), provides that the powers of a municipality under *the Municipal Act*, 2001 or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 227, of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, it is the role of the officers and employees of the municipality to implement council's decisions and establish administrative practices and procedures to carry out council's decisions; to undertake research and provide advice to council on the policies and programs of the municipality and to carry out other duties as required under this or any Act and other duties assigned by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS, by motion 05-G-475, it is deemed expedient that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie appoint a Community Emergency Management Coordinator for the City of Barrie and to repeal By-law 2013-095.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Jeffrey Steven Weber be appointed as Community Emergency Management Coordinator, in accordance with the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, for the City of Barrie for the term of his employment.
- 2. **THAT** By-law 2013-095 appointing John Russell Lynn as Community Emergency Management Program Coordinator, be repealed.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 15th day of December, 2014.

READ a third time and finally passed this 15th day of December, 2014.
