The Heritage Barrie Committee met and reports as follows:

PLAQUE IN HONOUR OF SIR ROBERT BARRIE

M. Johns, Committee Chair, introduced P. Diamond and invited him to provide comments on the dedication of a plaque to Sir Robert Barrie. Mr. Diamond explained his interest in history, and the importance of naming the City after Sir Robert Barrie. M. Johns explained that this subject is well-timed, and suggested the recognition be considered as part of the Heritage Trail, given Barrie's recent Twinning with the Borough of Harrogate.

HERITAGE TRAIL WORKING GROUP

M. Johns explained that the Heritage Trail was proposed by former Barrie Mayor Willard Kinzie to showcase the history and heritage of the City of Barrie. The Heritage Trail Working Group has been tasked with developing proposals for consideration by Barrie City Council.

W. Fischer, Supervisor of Parks Planning explained the components under consideration for the Heritage Trail, and outlined the proposals to date. He inquired if the Committee members were interested in contributing to the project as it develops.
