The Symposium will be moderated by Eleanor McMahon, road safety advocate, frequent speaker on Active Transportation Issues and founder of Share the Road Cycling Coalition, a cycling advocacy organization with branches across Ontario, Canada and the world. She is enthusiastic, passionate and highly knowledgeable about the many benefits to both persons and the municipality – health, economic, environmental - that well thought out AT investments can bring.

The purpose of the Symposium is two-fold:

First, it is our intention to help “change the conversation” by changing the thinking about Active Transportation (AT) – what it is, what investment in AT can bring to a municipality and what the municipality is missing or worse, losing, without it.

This objective will be accomplished on the evening of November 13. Over dinner, a panel of speakers, including former Mayor of Madison, Wisconsin, Dave Cieselewicz, will address a variety of topics relevant to elected officials and senior municipal staff. It will be our pleasure to have you as our guests.

Second, in response to requests from front line planning and engineering staff, we hope to help build capacity and collaboration among those staffers whose job it is to make AT work in the municipality, and who are called upon to justify these investments in fiscally challenging times.

This objective will be met on November 14<sup>th</sup> as we present a full day of hands on workshops, speakers and other practical resources for municipal planning, engineering, and public works staff, and the community-based planners they often work in concert with. This day will be available at a nominal cost.

Our request for a deputation will allow Eleanor McMahon, speaking on behalf of the planning group, to convey the invitation to council to attend the Symposium, particularly the evening of November 13<sup>th</sup>, and to help instill in them the imperative for their planning staff to attend the hands-on learning day.
