BY-LAW NUMBER 2025-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to further amend By-law 2023-032 being a by-law to appoint members to various committees, boards and commissions for the 2022 to 2026 Term of Council.

WHEREAS, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie may appoint representatives to various committees, boards and commissions;

AND WHEREAS, By-law 2023-032 was passed on the 29th day of March 2023 concerning appointments to committees, boards and commissions;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie adopted motions 25-G-070 and 25-G-090 to amend By-law 2023-032;
