

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-**

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to accept the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the Gilroy Plan of Subdivision (Phase 1 and Phase 2) registered as Plan 51M-750 and to assume the streets within this plan of subdivision for public use.

**WHEREAS** Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the "Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Municipal Act, 2001 or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to assume Balmoral Place, Chamboro Court, Spencer Drive, Parisian Crescent, Falcon Crescent, and those parts of Sovereign's Gate, Empire Drive, Prince William Way, Birkhall Place, Sandringham Drive, Pepin Court and Proclamation Drive identified on Plan 51M-750, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe;

**AND WHEREAS** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed Motion 11-G-276 delegating authority to the Director of Engineering to accept the municipal infrastructure within Plans of Subdivision;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Balmoral Place, Chamboro Court, Spencer Drive, Parisian Crescent, Falcon Crescent, and those parts of Sovereign's Gate, Empire Drive, Prince William Way, Birkhall Place, Sandringham Drive, Pepin Court and Proclamation Drive identified on Plan 51M-750, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe be assumed for public use.
- 2. **THAT** the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the Gilroy Plan of Subdivision (Phase 1 and Phase 2) registered as Plan 51M-750 be accepted.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2014.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2014.
