BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to establish Blocks 168 and 170 on Plan 51M-722, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as a public highway, and to name the highway Nathan Crescent and to establish Block 169 on Plan 51M-722, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as a public highway, and to name the highway Booth Lane.

WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 as amended (the "Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, *inter alia*, public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Municipal Act, 2001 or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to confirm its jurisdiction and to establish for the purposes of a public highway Blocks 168, 169 and 170, Plan 51M-722, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe and to name Blocks 168 and 170 Nathan Crescent and to name Block 169 Booth Lane;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts the following:

1. **THAT** Blocks 168, 169 and 170, Plan 51M-722, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe are established as a public highway.
2. **THAT** Block 168 and 170, Plan 51M-722, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe are named Nathan Crescent and that such name be affixed at the corners of the highway.
3. **THAT** Block 169, Plan 51M-722, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe is named Booth Lane and that such name be affixed at the corners of the highway.
4. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 24th day of November, 2014.

READ a third time and finally passed this 24th day of November, 2014.
