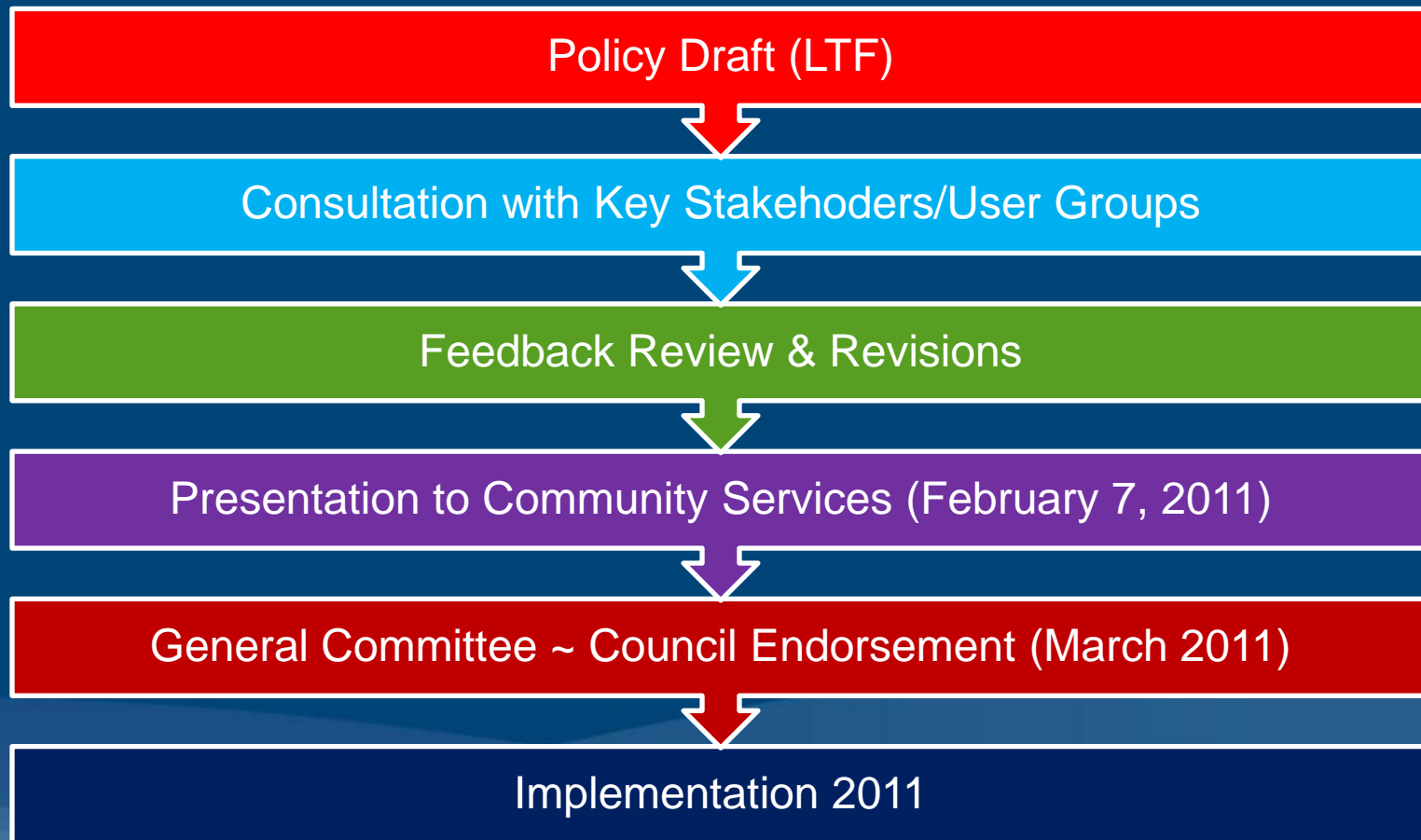

# ICE ALLOCATION POLICY

## WHY AN ICE ALLOCATION POLICY?

- To clearly identify the corporation's **commitment, philosophy** and **guiding principles** governing the equitable assignment and management of indoor ice time within municipally owned arena facilities.
- To clearly identify corporate **goals, objectives** and **standards** of practice.
- To ensure **structure** and **consistency** in the ice allocation process.
- To be **fair** and **equitable**

# ICE ALLOCATION POLICY

## POLICY HIGHLIGHTS – Section 6

### 2. Residency Requirement

- a) All Youth Partner Groups and Adult Seasonal Client Groups will be required to produce **Registrant Data Information** to the City of Barrie.
- b) Ice Allocation **eligibility** for the upcoming season of play will be based on registrant data information.
- c) **Priority** shall be given to City of Barrie residents and residents of a surrounding municipality with a City of Barrie Council endorsed Residency Recognition Agreement

# ICE ALLOCATION POLICY

## POLICY HIGHLIGHTS - Section 11

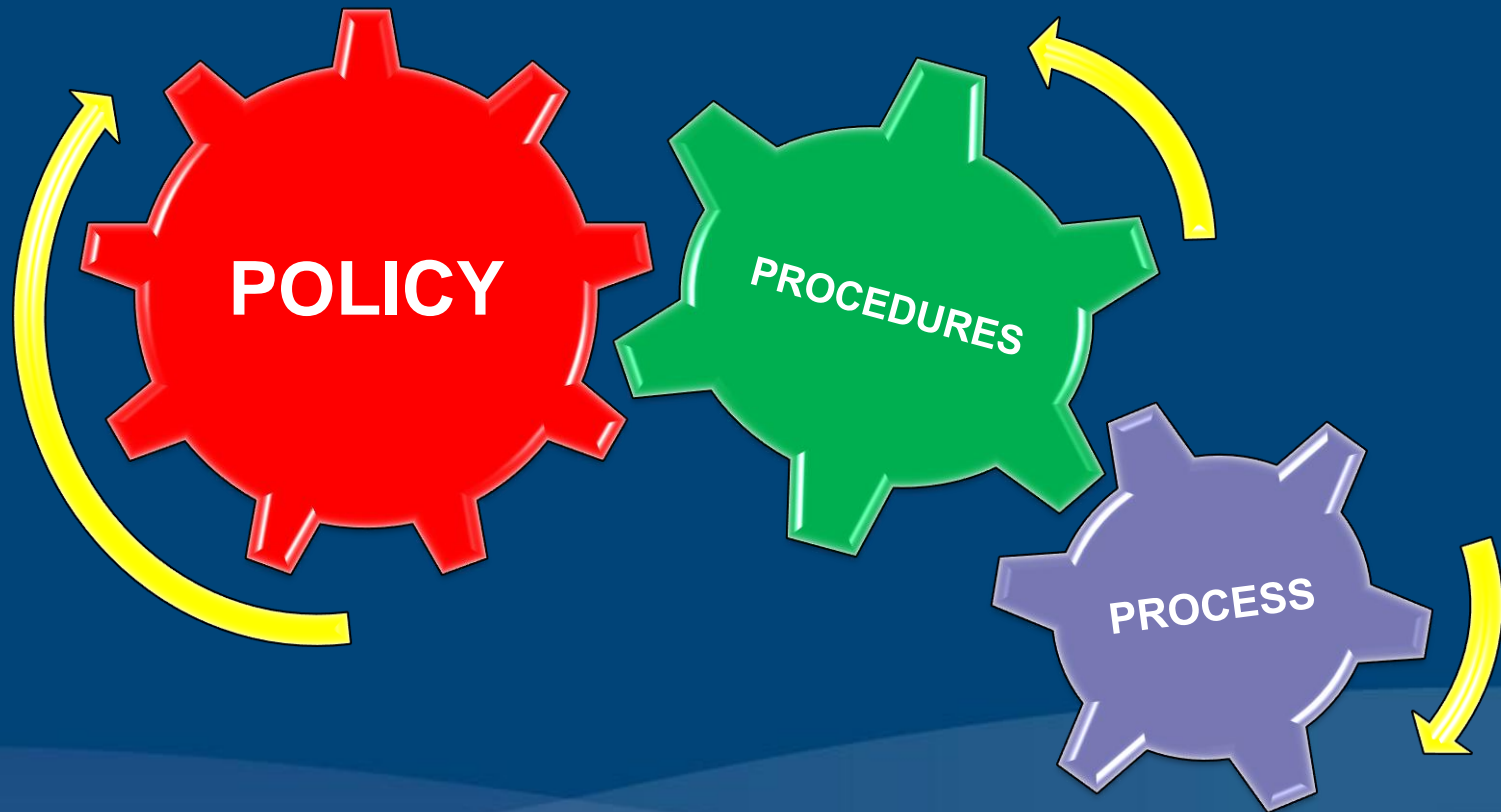
### 3. Definition of Ice Time Hour

- a) A one (1) hour block of ice time shall be defined as **fifty (50) minutes** of ice time play with the remaining ten (10) minutes of time utilized by facility operations staff for ice maintenance purposes.
- b) **Block bookings** – least impact

Where there exists only one ice pad within a municipal arena,  
**all rentals shall commence on the hour mark.**

Where there exists two ice pads within a municipal arena,  
**all rentals shall commence on the ½ hour mark.**
