SINGLE USE PLASTICS AT CITY OWNED FACILITIES AND CITY PERMITTED EVENTS

1. That staff in the Business Performance and Environmental Sustainability Department, Recreation and Culture Department and Access Barrie develop a program to encourage local businesses and event organizers to discontinue the provision of single-use plastics at their establishments or events with an approach suitable to their operation and that the City implement a voluntary ban of single-use plastics at all City Facilities and City Special Events.
2. That to encourage participation in the voluntary single-use plastics ban, City staff develop an associated Outreach Program that complements Federal, Provincial, and Municipal Circular Economy Initiatives.
