

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2013-**

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to accept the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the Sedgewood Way extension and to assume the street for public use.

**WHEREAS** Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the "Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Municipal Act, 2001 or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to assume part of Sedgewood Way described as Part of Lot 4, Concession 13, formerly Township of Innisfil, being Part 11 on Plan 51R-36703, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe;

**AND WHEREAS** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed Motion 11-G-276 delegating authority to the Director of Engineering to accept the municipal infrastructure within Plans of Subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** that part of Sedgewood Way described as Part of Lot 4, Concession 13, formerly Township of Innisfil, being Part 11 on Plan 51R-36703, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe be assumed for public use.
- 2. **THAT** the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the Sedgewood Way extension be accepted.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2013.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2013.
