The Heritage Barrie Committee met and reports as follows:

PRESENTATION BY THE BARRIE HISTORICAL ARCHIVE

Dr. Travis Doucette, Chairperson of the Barrie Historical Archive provided a presentation regarding the Barrie Historical Archive Project.

Dr. Doucette discussed slides concerning the following topics:

- A potential partnership with the Heritage Barrie Committee;
- The Vision Statement;
- The Mission Statement;
- Photographs of historical buildings;
- Background information regarding the development of the Barrie Historical Archive;
- An overview of achievement highlights including:
 - Documents scanned and archived to date;
 - The development of a strong social media presence;
 - The official launch;
- An overview of the leadership structure;
- An overview of the partnerships with the City of Barrie, institutions, historical associations, private businesses and local media;
- An overview of the 2016 annual budget; and
- The objectives for June 2016.

In closing, Dr. Doucette requested that the Heritage Barrie Committee consider forming a partnership with the Barrie Historical Archive. Dr. Doucette also asked that the Heritage Barrie Committee consider donating to the start up costs of the Barrie Historical Archive.

**CORRESPONDENCE FROM THE NATIONAL TRUST FOR CANADA
REQUESTING A DONATION TO THE LAUNCH PAD INITIATIVE**

ONTARIO HERITAGE CONFERENCE - MAY 2016

S. Lewis provided an update regarding his experience at the 2016 Ontario Heritage Conference held in Stratford, Ontario.

Mr. Lewis discussed the workshops he attended which included: Changes Needed for Heritage Preservation - A Politician's Perspective, Re-Use and Revitalization of Former Railway Buildings and Heritage Conservation Districts - Protecting Ontario's Post War Heritage.

Mr. Lewis noted that the workshops shared a common theme which emphasized the importance of developing community partnerships to preserve historical community assets.

CELEBRATE BARRIE - UPDATE

D. Exel provided an update regarding the Celebrate Barrie event held at Centennial Park on June 4, 2016. Ms. Exel noted that the Heritage Barrie Committee partnered with the Barrie Historical Archive to operate a heritage display booth. She commented that many visitors expressed interest in the heritage information booth.

2016 WORK PLAN REVIEW

Councillor, B. Ward reviewed the draft 2016 Heritage Barrie Committee Work Plan. The Committee discussed tasks associated with the Heritage Walking Tours tentatively scheduled for the Fall of 2016.
