BY-LAW NUMBER 2014 -

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to appoint a Lottery Licensing Officer to provide for the licensing of lotteries in the City of Barrie.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15, as amended, the Council of any municipality may appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers who shall be Peace Officers for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that Sections 8 and 11 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to (a) enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and, (b) enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.M.25 ("the Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 227, of the Municipal Act, 2001, it is the role of the officers and employees of the municipality to implement council's decisions and establish administrative practices and procedures to carry out council's decisions; to undertake research and provide advise to council on the policies and programs of the municipality and to carry out other duties as required under this or any Act and other duties assigned by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to appoint a Deputy Lottery Licensing Officer.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Ronald Patrick Osborne is hereby appointed Deputy Lottery Licensing Officer for the City of Barrie.
2. **THAT** Ronald Patrick Osborne shall hold office during the term of his employment and shall exercise all the authority, powers and rights and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by statute or by-laws are or may be conferred or imposed upon the Deputy Lottery Licensing Officer and any other duties that may be imposed by Council.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 13th day of January, 2014.

READ a third time and finally passed this 13th day of January, 2014.
